<p>About the Bursary</p>	<p>Muslimin Trust Fund Association (MTFA) was established as a company limited by guarantee on 31 August 1904 and as a charitable organisation on 23 November 1984.</p> <p>MTFA awards bursaries using the <i>Zakat</i> funds collected for the Hijrah year. The aim of these awards is to provide financial assistance for Muslim students from lower-income families who are pursuing tertiary education.</p>

Applicants are to make a copy of their application for their own record. ➤ The Selection Committee will judge each application on its own merits. The decision of the Selection Committee is final. MTFA reserves the right to not disclose the reasons for approving or rejecting any application, and to reject any incomplete/late application.
